c. _____ It is a very large country in North America. It has 50 states, from the Atlantic to the Pacific Ocean. The capital city is Washington, D.C., but the largest city is New York. It is famous for Hollywood movies, jazz music, hamburgers, and apple pie. Many tourists visit the Grand Canyon, the Statue of Liberty, and Disneyland. Its flag has 13 red and white stripes and 50 white stars on a blue rectangle.

d. _____ It is an island country in East Asia. It has four main islands and many mountains, including a famous volcano that is covered with snow on top. The capital city is Tokyo, which is very big and modern. People in this country eat rice, fish, and noodles. Sushi and tempura are very popular foods. Many tourists visit to see ancient temples, cherry, and bullet trains. Its flag is white with a large red circle in the center.
