

WH Questions Structure in Present Simple

1. WH Word + do/does + subject + base verb?

- Use **do** with I, you, we, they.
- Use **does** with he, she, it.

2. Examples:

- **What** does he do on weekends?
(He goes hiking.)
- **Who** do you call for help?
(I call my friend.)
- **Where** does she work?
(She works in a bank.)
- **When** do you have your piano lessons?
(I have them on Fridays.)
- **Why** do they study so much?
(Because they want good grades.)
- **How** do you get to school?
(I take the bus.)

WH- Word	Spanish Translation	New Example
What	¿Qué?	What do you need for the project?
Who	¿Quién?	Who is your favorite author?
Where	¿Dónde?	Where do you usually study?
When	¿Cuándo?	When do your classes start?
Why	¿Por qué?	Why do you enjoy reading fiction?
How	¿Cómo?	How do you prepare for a test?

Information questions and question words

We use question words in information questions.

*How do the two friends escape?
Where can I get a cup of coffee?
Why are you driving slowly?*

We answer these questions by giving some information.

*They run away through the trees.
In the coffee shop in the bookstore.
Because there is a lot of snow on the road.*

Negative statements

We make the negative by adding **not** after the auxiliary verb **do/does** in the Present Simple.

Tom doesn't (does not) work in an office.

We add **not** after the verbs **be** or **can**.

Rita isn't (is not) an artist.

Tom can't (cannot) finish his comic strip at first.

We usually use the contracted form **-n't**.
