

# MIXED CONDITIONALS



Mixed Conditionals (Past → Present): These show how an action that did or did not happen in the past affects the current situation.

STRUCTURE	EXAMPLE
If + <b>Past Perfect</b> , ... would + infinitive.	If I <b>had studied</b> medicine, I would be a doctor now.
