hurricane

The word *hurricane* comes from the Spanish word *huracan*. (A) _____ originates from the name of a Mayan god. In the Mayan creation myth, Huracan is the weather god of wind, storm, and fire, and he is one of the three gods who created humans. However, the first humans angered the gods, so Huracan caused a great flood.

The first Spanish contact with the Mayan civilization was in 1517. Spanish explorers who were passing through the Caribbean experienced a hurricane and picked up the word for it from the people in the area. In English, one of the early uses of *hurricane* was in a play by Shakespeare in 1608.
