To be or not to be on social media?

It seems impossible to go anywhere nowadays without feeling the presence of some form of social media. Let's start with the positives. Social media has the ability to connect more people more quickly than any other means of communication in history. But what's so good about that? Well, for those people who have a strong **social conscience** and want to be **outspoken** about it, they can reach a large audience and hopefully gain support for their cause, for example through sharing a **petition** for people to sign. People also use it to raise money for charitable causes or to fund new business ideas. It's also a great way to find out information about what's going on in your local area, for example, groups to join or new fitness classes to try. Again, it's all about bringing **like-minded** people together, not only virtually, but physically.

Now onto the negatives. Social media sites can be extremely addictive, and people waste a lot of time online, for example, looking at photos of people they hardly even know. While it can be a great way of arranging meet-ups in the real world, a lot of people also spend so much time talking to their online friends that their face-to-face relationships **suffer**. It is also thought that using social media increases anxiety in young people because they feel under so much pressure to **maintain** their online presence.
