- ✓ completed actions in the past
- ✓ actions that started and finished in the past
- ✓ past habits
- ✓ past facts



REGULAR VERBS (add -ed)

play → played
win → won
score → scored
watch → watched

IRREGULAR VERBS

be → was / were
win → won
come → came
see → saw
have → had

TIME EXPRESSIONS

- yesterday
- last week
- last month
- last year
- ago
- in 2018
- in the final
- on Sunday
