Adjectives with one syllable, add: '-er' or '-r' + 'than'

cold

"In Canada, winter is colder than summer." Adjectives with two or more syllables, add: 'more' + 'than'

ex-pen-sive

"This book is more expensive than that book."

Irregular Comparative Adjectives

good - better than

bad - worse than

for – farther than further than
