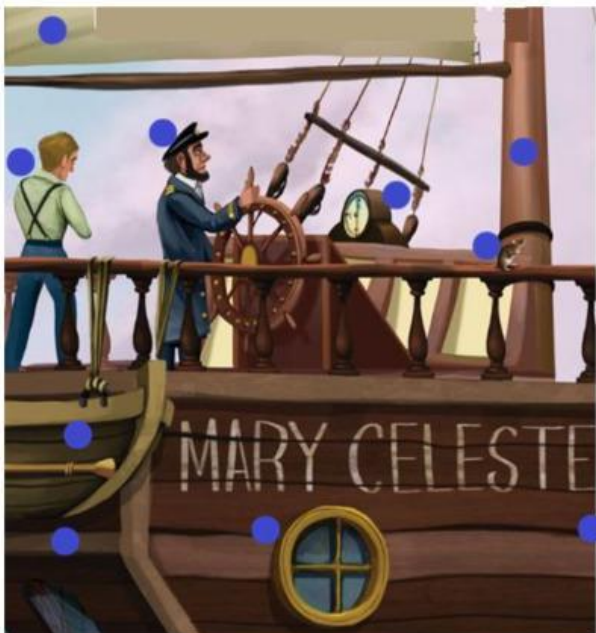

- En frases **negativas** y en **preguntas**.
- **VA SIEMPRE AL FINAL DE LA FRASE.**
