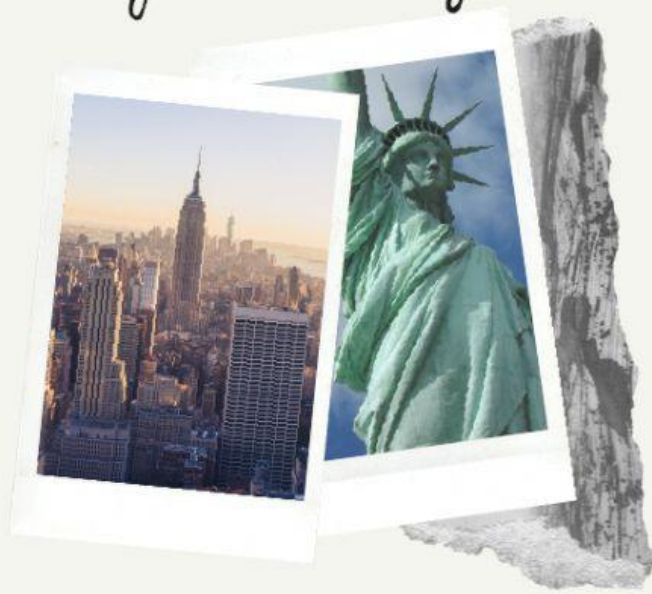


Packing... destiny...
