Tesla – The Electric Car

Tesla is a company founded by Elon Musk. It **produces** electric cars that **do not use** fossil fuels. Instead, Tesla's vehicles **run** on rechargeable batteries and renewable energy. Today, Tesla **sells** millions of cars worldwide. Many scientists **believe** the electric car **is** the future of transportation because it **reduces** CO2 emissions significantly.

Artificial Intelligence (AI)

Artificial Intelligence, or AI, **refers** to computer systems that **perform** tasks that normally require human intelligence. Companies like Google and OpenAI **develop** AI tools used by millions every day. AI **helps** doctors diagnose diseases and **transforms** education. However, many experts **consider** AI a "double-edged sword" because it also **raises** concerns about privacy and jobs.

The Printing Press – Gutenberg

Johannes Gutenberg **invented** the printing press around 1440 in Germany. Before this invention, books **were** extremely expensive. The printing press **allows** people to produce books quickly and at low cost. It **makes** knowledge accessible to everyone. Historians **consider** it one of the most important inventions in history because it **spreads** ideas rapidly.
