

F. Graphic-Based Questions

The answers for graphic-based questions are not directly stated in the conversations. Instead, you have to draw a conclusion based on the information that is presented by the speakers *and* what is shown in the graphic.

Graphic-based questions always have the same preface ("Look at the graphic."). The second part of the question can be phrased in a variety of ways:

- Look at the graphic. What time will the concert be held?
- Look at the graphic. Where is the post office?
- Look at the graphic. Which number should Ms. Colbert call?
- Look at the graphic. Who should Mr. Roberts contact?

Sample Item: Graphic-Based Question

Woman: Hello, sir. May I take your order now or would you like more time to think about it?
Man: I'm ready to order now. I'd like the Herb Chicken and an iced tea.
Woman: Oh, I'm sorry. We're all out of that already. It was very popular tonight.
Man: Alright. Then how about the Bison Burger?
Woman: I'm sorry again. The only dish still available is at the bottom of the Special Menu.
Man: I see. Well, I'll have that one, then.

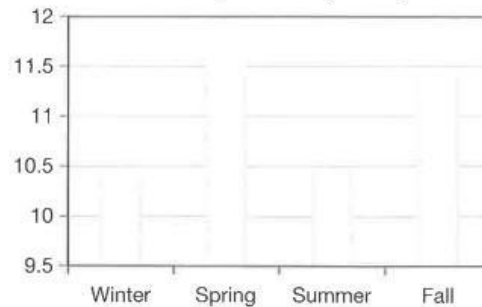
