Colon (:)

A colon is used:

- To introduce a list
- To introduce an explanation or example
- After a greeting in a business letter

Example:

I need three supplies: paper, pencils, and markers.

Semicolon (;)

A semicolon is used:

- To join two closely related independent clause
- To separate items in a list when the items already contain commas

Example:

The rain stopped; we went outside.
