

COMMUNITY PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS

Street crime, noise pollution, and heavy traffic are serious problems in many cities. I think local governments should take action to improve people's quality of life.

First, something has to be done to reduce street crime. More police officers should be required to patrol dangerous areas, and security cameras should be installed in public places.

1. When you think something is a good idea

Subject + should be required to + verb

Example: Clubs should be required to install soundproof walls.

Subject + shouldn't be allowed to + verb

Example: People shouldn't be allowed to make loud noises at night.

2. When you think something is absolutely necessary

Subject + mustn't be permitted

Example: Dangerous driving mustn't be permitted.

Something + has to be done + infinitive phrase

Example: Something has to be done to stop street crime.

A rule/law + has to be made

Example: A law has to be passed to control pollution.
