




ORDINAL NUMBERS

We use ordinal numbers when we want to show the order or position of something or someone in a sequence.

We normally add a TH to the end of a cardinal number to make it an ordinal number. Be careful of the spelling exceptions below:

1st first

2nd second

3rd third

4th fourth

5th fifth

6th sixth

7th seventh

8th eighth

9th ninth

10th tenth

11th eleventh

12th twelfth

13th thirteenth

14th fourteenth

15th fifteenth

16th sixteenth

17th seventeenth

18th eighteenth

19th nineteenth

20th twentieth

21st twenty-first

22nd twenty-second

23rd twenty-third

24th twenty-fourth

CENTURIES: Shakespeare was born in the **16th** century.


FLOORS OF A BUILDING: His office is on the **tenth** floor.

SEQUENCE/ORDER:


My team came **second** in the league.
