One evening, Nick thought of a song that he wanted to hear, but the song wasn't on the radio. He went to the basement and got his old guitar. He started to play. His parents were happy to listen to his music again.



★ Nick didn't 2.6 for one week.

★ Nick's parents were 2.7 when he played his guitar again.
