#### SILVER MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK

Silver Mountain National Park is one of the most famous tourist attractions in northern Canada. The park covers more than **1,200 square kilometers** and welcomes around **500,000 visitors each year**. The highest peak in the park is **Silver Peak**, which rises to **2,850 meters above sea level**.

The weather in the park changes throughout the year. In summer, temperatures are usually between **18°C and 25°C**, making it a popular season for hiking and camping. In winter, temperatures can fall below **-10°C**, and many tourists come to enjoy skiing and snowboarding. The park receives about **150 centimeters of snowfall** each year.

Visitors can take part in many outdoor activities. Popular choices include mountain climbing, cycling, fishing in the Silver River, and wildlife watching. The park is home to over **200 species of birds** and many wild animals such as deer and foxes. There are also several viewing platforms where tourists can enjoy beautiful views of the mountains and the river.

Although the park is located about **120 kilometers** from the nearest city, it is easy to reach by car or bus. During weekends and holidays, however, traffic on the main road can become quite heavy, especially during the summer months. Park managers recommend arriving early in the morning to avoid delays and find parking more easily.
