FIFA WORLD CUP 2026

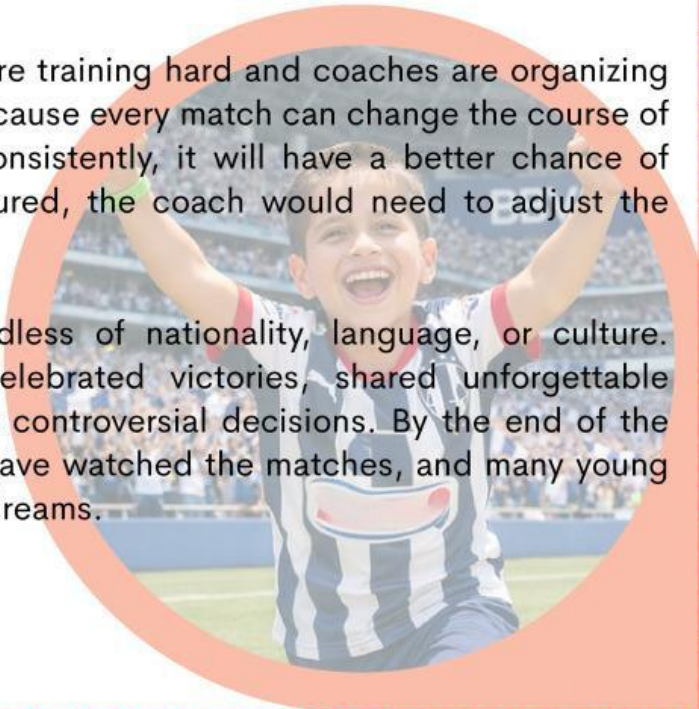
