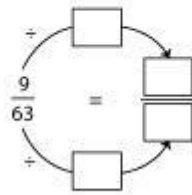

Simplify each fraction using the GCF method.

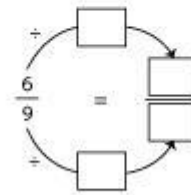
1) $\frac{9}{63}$

GCF of 9 and 63 = _____



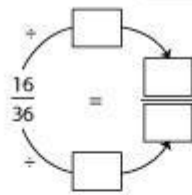
2) $\frac{6}{9}$

GCF of 6 and 9 = _____



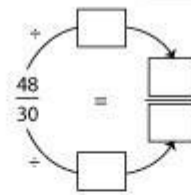
3) $\frac{16}{36}$

GCF of 16 and 36 = _____



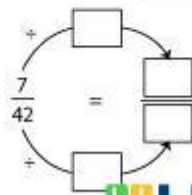
4) $\frac{48}{30}$
