

## Comparative Adjective (1)

Rule	How to change	Examples
1. Most Adjectives	Add <b>-er</b>	small → smaller    long → longer
2. Ending in <b>Consonant + y</b>	Drop <b>-y</b> , add <b>-ies</b>	happy → happier    pretty → prettier
3. Ending in <b>1 vowel + 1 consonant</b>	Double final consonant, add <b>-ing</b>	big → bigger    hot → hotter
4. Irregular	No rules	good → better    bad → worse
