A. GRAMMAR

Present perfect (*Thì hiện tại hoàn thành*)

- Cách dùng:

Diễn tả sự việc **bắt đầu trong quá khứ và tiếp tục ở hiện tại.**

I have lived here **for** five years.

Diễn tả sự việc đã **xảy ra nhiều lần trong quá khứ.**

I have visited this museum **many times**.

Diễn tả sự việc **vừa mới xảy ra và gây hậu quả tới hiện tại.**

She has **just** finished her homework.

- Dấu hiệu:

- **before, never, ever, yet, already, the first/second/... time, just, recently/lately, ...**

Ví dụ: Have you **ever** travelled to Germany?

- **for + khoảng thời gian (được bao lâu)**

Ví dụ: She has taught Spanish **for 3 years**.

- **since + mốc thời gian (từ bao giờ)**

Ví dụ: She has lived here **since I was born**.

	Structure	Example
Positive	S + have/has + V3/ed (+ O)	We have known each other for a long time.
Negative	S + haven't/hasn't + V3/ed (+ O) S + have/has + never + V3/ed (+ O)	He has never played soccer.
Yes/No questions	Have/Has + S + V3/ed (+O)? → Yes, S + have/has . → No, S + haven't/hasn't .	Have you been to Japan? → Yes, I have . → No, I haven't .
