Observing and describing an image

Observe an image and describe the actions of five people using the **present continuous** tense. Focus on clear, accurate sentences.

Use the **present continuous** to describe actions happening now.

Concept	Explanation and Example
Present Continuous	Used for actions happening now. Formed with the verb 'to be' (am/is/are) + a verb ending in -ing. Example: 'She is running.'

Analyze the Scene
