I. Usage & Meaning:

3 WAYS TO USE SIMPLE PRESENT	
USE	EXAMPLE
1 Habits and routines We use it for actions that happen regularly, habitually, or many times. 	 I get up at 6 o'clock every day.
2 General truths and facts We use it for facts that are always true, things that never change, or natural events. 	 The sun rises in the east.
3 Schedules and timetables We use it for events in the future that are part of a schedule, timetable, or program. 	 The bus leaves at 8 a.m. every day.

II. Form with action verbs

Subject	Positive (+)	Negative (-)	Question & Short answer
I/ You/ We/ They	S + Verb-inf <i>eg: They live in Hanoi.</i>	S + do not (don't) + V-inf <i>eg: They don't live in Hue.</i>	Do + S + V-inf? - Yes, S do - No, S do not (don't) Do they live here? → Yes, they do . / No, they don't .
He/ She/ It	S + V-s/-es <i>eg: He lives in Hanoi.</i>	S + does not (doesn't) + V-inf <i>eg: He doesn't live in Hue.</i>	Does + Subject + V-inf? - Yes, S does - No, S do not (doesn't) Does he live here? → Yes, he does . / No, he doesn't .

✗ Crucial Spelling Rules for Third Person Singular

- Most verbs: Add -s (walk → walks, read → reads)
- Verbs ending in -ch, -sh, -s, -x, -z, -o: Add -es (watch → watches, go → goes, fix → fixes)
- Verbs ending in *consonant* + -y: Change -y to -ies (study → studies, fly → flies)
