Read the tale of "Goldilocks and the Three Bears" carefully. Then, choose the best answer for each question based on the story.

Goldilocks and the Three Bears

Once upon a time, three bears lived together in a small cottage in the forest. There were Father Bear, Mother Bear, and Baby Bear. One morning, Mother Bear made three bowls of porridge for breakfast. The porridge was too hot to eat, so the bears decided to take a walk while it cooled down.
