

CVC Words

The alphabet has 26 letters, they are A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, W, X, Y, Z.

a, e, i, o, u are called '**vowels**' and the remaining 21 letters are called '**consonants**'.

CVC words are simple words that follow the **consonant-vowel-consonant** pattern.

e.g. bat, pen, kit, cot, and bud.
