### USED TO

We use **used to** + infinitive to talk about past habits or situations that are no longer true.

#### ✓ Affirmative

| Subject                             | used to | Verb |
|-------------------------------------|---------|------|
| I / You / He / She / It / We / They | used to | play |

Example: I **used to** play football.

#### ✗ Negative

| Subject                             | didn't | use to | Verb |
|-------------------------------------|--------|--------|------|
| I / You / He / She / It / We / They | didn't | use to | play |

Example: She **didn't use to** like smartphones.

#### ❓ Questions

| Did | Subject | use to | Verb  |
|-----|---------|--------|-------|
| Did | you     | use to | play? |

Example: Did you **use to** play computer games?

### PRESENT PERFECT

#### ✓ Affirmative

| Subject             | have / has | Past participle |
|---------------------|------------|-----------------|
| I / You / We / They | have       | finished        |
| He / She / It       | has        | finished        |

#### ✗ Negative

| Subject             | haven't / hasn't | Past participle |
|---------------------|------------------|-----------------|
| I / You / We / They | haven't          | finished        |
| He / She / It       | hasn't           | finished        |

#### ❓ Questions

| Have / Has | Subject | Past participle |
|------------|---------|-----------------|
| Have       | you     | finished?       |
| Has        | she     | finished?       |

### FOR vs SINCE

Use **FOR** + a period of time.  
for two hours • for five years

Use **SINCE** + the starting point.  
since Monday • since 2022  
since my birthday
