When Maya's headphones stopped working, the shop assistant offered her a discount on a new pair. Maya was tempted, but she did not like the idea of throwing the old headphones away. At home, she watched several videos and discovered that the problem was only a loose wire. After an hour of careful work, the headphones worked again.

That small success gave Maya an idea. Lots of people in her town replaced things as soon as they broke, even when the problem was simple. She asked the local library if she could use a room once a month for a repair club. At the first meeting, only three classmates came, bringing a lamp, a school bag and a toy car. None of them knew much about repairs, but they learned together.

The club has one important rule: the owner of the broken item must stay and help. Maya says the club is not a free repair service. Its aim is to show people that they can understand how things work. Volunteers are careful about safety, so they do not repair phones with broken screens or anything that might be dangerous.

After six months, the town council gave the club a small grant for basic tools. Council members liked the project because it reduced waste and brought different generations together. Older neighbours often bring items to the club and share useful knowledge with the students.

The work is not always easy. Sometimes spare parts are difficult to find, and some visitors expect repairs to be finished quickly. To solve this, Maya keeps notes about common problems and posts simple guides online. The club has now stopped more than 120 items from being thrown away. Maya knows that buying something new is sometimes necessary, but she believes repair should be the first thing people try, not the last.
