People often like to travel so they can see beautiful places and remember them. But can you travel to 'feel' the places? For Katie Woods and her mum, Candie, the answer is yes. But Katie was always there to help.

After six years, the mother and daughter finished exploring all 75 state parks in Minnesota. Candie's adventure was much more than a walking trip. She couldn't see the **nature** around her with her eyes. But thanks to her daughter, Candie saw it with her **heart**.
