Technology

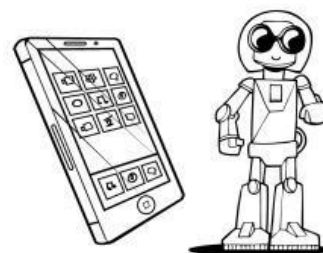
Many technological items are produced in Japan, including mobile phones, computers and laptops, but more smartphones are produced in South Korea. Technology in Japan is more advanced in robotics,
