Formal Partings

Expression	Meaning (Bahasa Indonesia)	When to Use
Goodbye.		General and polite farewell.
Goodbye for now.		Leaving but expecting to meet again.
Have a nice day.		Polite farewell in daily situations.
Have a good day.		Common polite farewell.
Have a wonderful day.		Friendly and polite farewell.
Have a good evening.		Leaving someone in the evening.
Take care.		Polite and caring farewell.
See you again.		When expecting to meet again.
See you soon.		Meeting again soon.
It was a pleasure meeting you.		Ending a first meeting politely.
It was nice talking to you.		Ending a conversation politely.
I hope to see you again.		Formal farewell.
Farewell.		Very formal or emotional farewell.

Informal Partings

Expression	Meaning (Bahasa Indonesia)	When to Use
Bye!		Common farewell among friends.
Bye-bye!		Friendly and casual farewell.
See you!		Casual farewell.
See you later!		Meeting again later.
Catch you later!		Very casual farewell.
Talk to you later!		Ending a conversation.
Talk to you soon!		Expecting to talk again soon.
See you tomorrow!		Meeting again the next day.
See you next time!		Meeting again in the future.
Take it easy!		Friendly farewell.
Have fun!		When someone is going to an activity.
Later!		Very informal farewell.
So long!		Informal, less common today.
I'm off.		Telling friends you're leaving.
Gotta go!		Leaving because you're in a hurry.
See ya!		Informal pronunciation of 'See you'.
Good night.		Used when leaving at night or before bed.
