Evaluating Expressions

To **evaluate** an expression, substitute the given value for the variable and use the **order of operations (PEMDAS)**.

Example

Evaluate: $4x + 7$ when $x = 3$

Step 1: Substitute 3 for x .

$$4x + 7 \text{ when } x = 3$$

Step 2: Multiply.

$$4(3) + 7$$

Step 3: Add.

$$12 + 7$$
