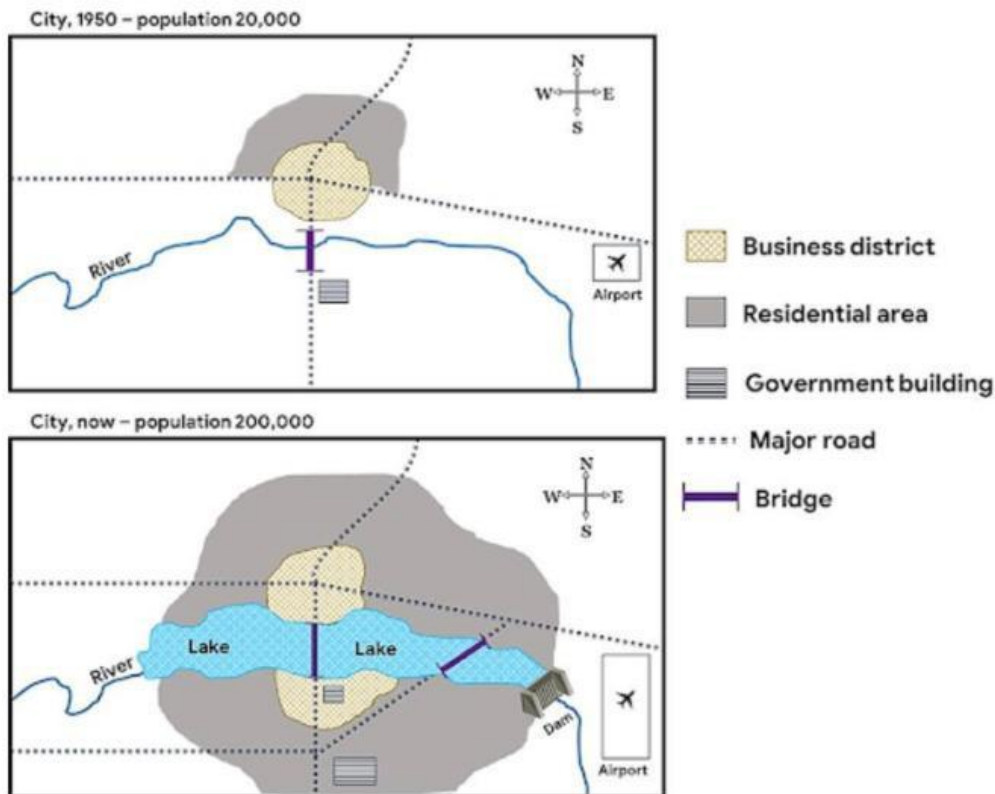


Task 1: The maps show a city in 1950 and now.



The maps illustrate the changes that have occurred in a city from 1950 to the present day.

Overall, along with a massive expansion in , the city's economic and public has grown significantly in both size and number. Additionally, the road has been expanded, and a major portion of the river has been into a lake.

In 1950, a business district was located in the center of the city. The northern half of this district was by a residential area, which was home to 20,000 people. At that time, there were only two main roads, which in the middle of the business district. One road ran from west to east, to an airport in the east. The other road ran from north to south and a bridge over a river that flowed from west to east. This bridge the residential area and business district to a government building in the south.

At present, the population has increased . As a result, the residential and business areas have expanded in all , forming two halves of a circle. These halves are divided by a large lake, which was created by building a dam on the eastern end of the original river. The northern includes the original business district, which remains largely , surrounded by the expanded residential area. The southern half is a version of the northern side. The original government building has been in size and is now located inside a new business district, while a new, larger government building has been constructed in the new residential area. Regarding transportation, the original main roads remain unchanged. However, a new main road has been built, intersecting with the old road near the new government building. One of this new road heads west, while the other heads northeast, crossing the lake via a new bridge before the old east-west road. Finally, the airport remains in its location but has expanded greatly.
