Rule	Examples
General rule: Add -S at the end of the Noun.	Cat > Cat <u>s</u> ; House > House <u>s</u> ; Guy > Guy <u>s</u>
If a singular noun ends in -S, -SS, -SH, -CH, -X, or -Z, the typical rule is to add -ES at the end to make it plural.	Wish > Wish <u>es</u> ; Cross > Cross <u>es</u> ; Tax > Tax <u>es</u> ; Blitz > Blitz <u>es</u>
When pluralizing most nouns ending in -F or -FE, you simply add -S. In some cases, you need to change -F or -FE to -VE before adding -S to form the plural version.	Belief > Belief <u>s</u> ; Chief > Chief <u>s</u> BUT Wife > Wiv <u>es</u> ; Elf > Elv <u>es</u> ; Wolf > Wolv <u>es</u>
When a singular noun ends in -Y and the letter before the -Y is a consonant, it is typically changed to -IES to form the plural noun.	City > Cit <u>ies</u> ; Puppy > Pupp <u>ies</u>
When a singular noun ends in -o, we usually add -es at the end, but there are exceptions.	Tomato > Tomato <u>es</u> ; Potato > Potato <u>es</u> BUT Photo > Photo <u>s</u> ; Piano > Piano <u>s</u>
Some Nouns are irregular. It means their plural form is a different word.	Person > People ; Mouse > Mice ; Tooth > Teeth ; Goose > Geese ; Child > Children
