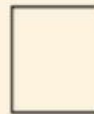

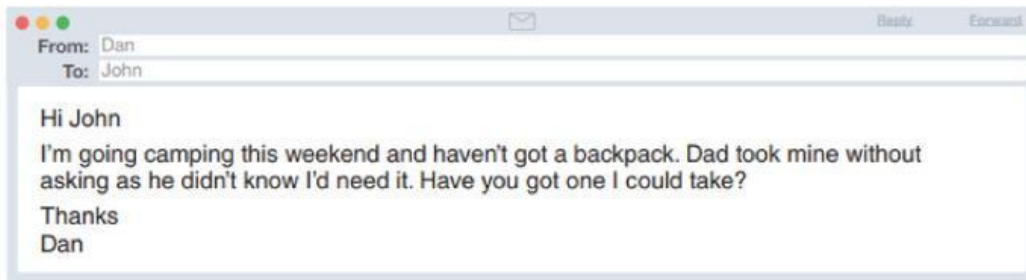

It is definitely the (3) stressful time of the year, but when the holidays finally arrive, exams are forgotten and everyone wants to concentrate on (4) fun.

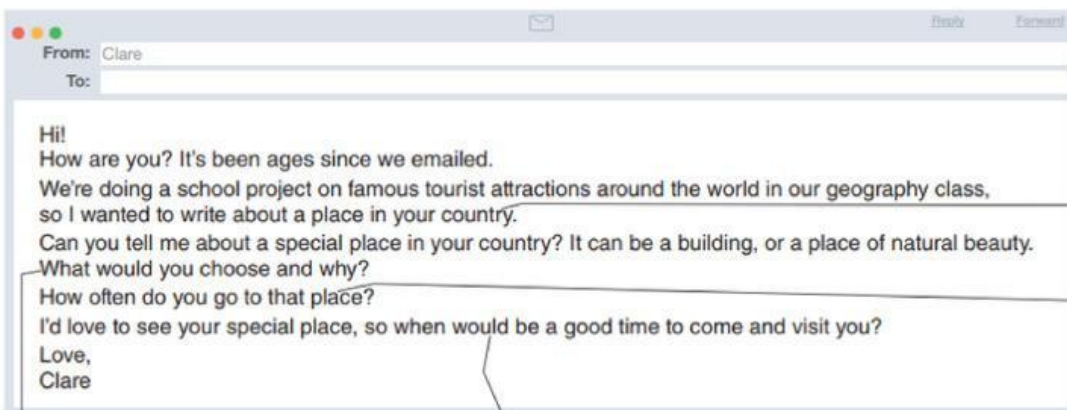
