Dive In: What Are We Learning?

Adjectives are describing words. They tell us more about a NOUN (a person, place, or thing) — like what it looks like, feels like, or how many there are.

Adverbs are describing words too, but they tell us more about a VERB (an action word) — like how, when, or where something happens. Many adverbs end in -ly!

Get ready to swim through the Great Barrier Reef with Marlin and Dory as we hunt for the perfect words to describe their adventure!

Examples From the Reef

Word Type	Example from the Reef	What It Describes
Adjective	"the tiny clownfish"	a noun (clownfish)
Adjective	"the forgetful fish"	a noun (fish, aka Dory)
Adverb	"swam nervously"	a verb (swam)
Adverb	"searched desperately"	a verb (searched)
