

VERB FORM

PRESENT PERFECT

Formula: have / has + past participle

Used for: Actions that happened in the past but have results now. Experiences or repeated actions up to now.

Examples :

- I have reached Mythical Glory this season.
- She has played Layla since the early days.
- We have won ten ranked matches in a row!

Connects the past to the present moment.



FUTURE PERFECT

Formula: will have + past participle

Used for: An action that will be completed before a specific future time or event.

Examples :

- By next month, I will have mastered all assassin heroes.
- Before the next update, our squad will have reached Mythical Honor.



Talks about what you'll finish or achieve before the future comes!



THE PERFECT FORM

The Perfect Form shows an action that is completed or has a connection to the present. It focuses on the result or experience, not the exact time it happened.

✦ *In MLBB, it's like showing your achievements, not when, but what you've accomplished!*

PAST PERFECT

Formula: had + past participle

Used for: An action completed Before another past event. Often used with time markers: before, after, by the time.

Examples :

- We had taken the Lord before the enemy arrived.
- He had used his ultimate before the clash even started.

Shows which past action happened first! Like setting up a combo before the battle begins!
