Lesson 4: the 3Rs and paper

This is the **recycling symbol**.

It reminds us of the **3Rs: Reduce, Reuse and Recycle**.

REDUCE

Use less paper

RECYCLE

Make new paper from old paper



REUSE

Use paper again

The order is important: first reduce, then reuse, and finally recycle.

This helps us take care of our planet.

Did you know?

Recycling paper as heavy as a small car can save about 17 trees.

Did you know?

One pack of paper needs a lot of water: about 5,100 small bottles!

Did you know?

One piece of paper can be recycled up to 7 times!
