- ▶ **to build something** to make something by putting parts together
- ▶ **to decorate something** to make something look attractive by putting something on it

These are all common things that other things are made of:

- ▶ **cardboard** very thick, stiff paper
- ▶ **leather** the skin of animals, used to make things like shoes
- ▶ **material** cloth used for making things like clothes
- ▶ **metal** a hard substance such as gold or iron
- ▶ **plastic** a substance that is made by people, can be made into different shapes, and is difficult to break
- ▶ **wood** a substance that comes from trees
