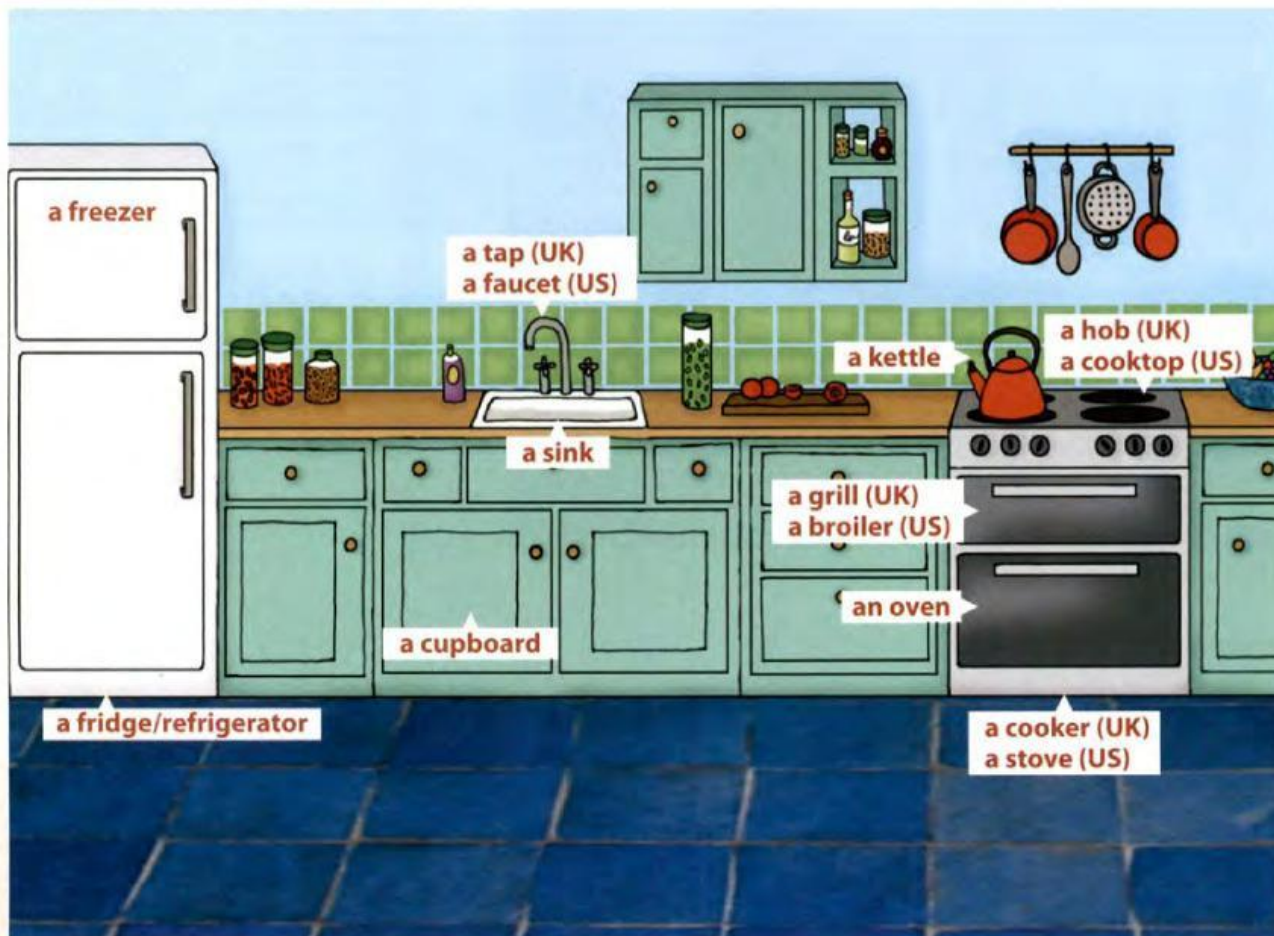

Phrasal verbs
