A. Grammar Box

We use **many** with **countable nouns**.

Examples

- There are **many** books.
- There are **many** chairs.
- There are **many** pencils.

We use **much** with **uncountable nouns**.

Examples

- There isn't **much** water.
- There isn't **much** paper.
- There isn't **much** homework.

We use **a lot of** with **countable and uncountable nouns**.

Examples

- There are **a lot of** computers.
- There are **a lot of** rulers.
- There is **a lot of** juice.
