Passage 7

Some people use oral medicines and antibacterial creams. However, not many people can afford these, which is why they prefer home remedies. Lemon, orange, banana and carrot are only some of the natural remedies people can use at home to help treat acne.

Question

In treating acne, most individuals choose to use home remedies because they are the quickest means to get rid of pimple marks.

Passage 8

A meteor is also called a falling star or a shooting star. People can see a falling star when a small particle from outer space enters the Earth's atmosphere. The impact between the particle and the Earth's atmosphere causes the particle to become very hot. Due to the very high temperature during impact, the particle is set ablaze and will look like it is glowing. Yet, a meteor does not actually land on the Earth's surface because it dissolves into dust. Particles that do land on Earth, however, are called meteorites.

Question

A meteor becomes incredibly hot when it crashes into the Earth's atmosphere.
