Use **has got** to say that he or she has a feature. Use **hasn't got** to say that the feature is not there.

Positive	Negative
He has got short hair.	He hasn't got a beard.
She has got blue eyes.	She hasn't got glasses.

HIS / HER

Use **his** for a boy or man. Use **her** for a girl or woman. These words show who something belongs to.

	This is Ben. His hair is short. His eyes are brown.
	This is Emma. Her hair is dark. Her glasses are black.

Remember: He -> his She -> her
