ELENA'S FIRST DAY AT GREEN VALLEY PARK

Good morning! My name is Elena Torres. I am an Ecuadorian park ranger at Green Valley National Park. Today is Monday, and it is my first day at the new visitor centre. I am excited and ready to work.

At 8:00 a.m., a group of twelve visitors arrives. Four visitors are from Canada, three are from Brazil, and five are from Ecuador. Elena smiles and says, 'Welcome to Green Valley National Park! I am Ranger Elena. How are you today?' The visitors answer, 'We are great, thank you!'

A Canadian visitor asks Elena to spell her last name. She says, 'T-O-R-R-E-S.' Then, Elena gives the group a map. It has three trails. The first trail is short and easy. The second trail is longer, and the third trail is closed today. There is a baby bear near that area, so visitors cannot enter it.

Before the walk, Elena explains the park rules. Visitors must stay on the trail. They must put their rubbish in a bin, and they must not feed the animals. A responsible visitor protects plants, animals and water. Elena checks the group's water bottles and hats. One visitor has an umbrella because the afternoon may be rainy.

The group chooses the first trail. On the way, they see an eagle, two colourful birds and a beautiful river. Elena is happy because everyone follows the rules. At the end of the visit, she says, 'Thank you for being responsible. Have a safe trip!' The visitors are tired, but they are very happy.
