Laura isn't flying to Boston at 8 p.m.

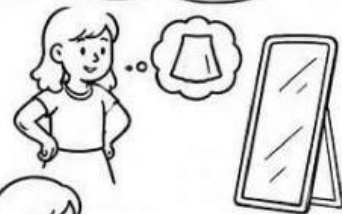
