Use	Structure	Example
Một người / vật sở hữu	noun + 's	This is Anna's bag.
Danh từ số nhiều có tận cùng là -s	danh từ số nhiều + '	This is the students' classroom.
Danh từ số nhiều không kết thúc bằng -s	danh từ số nhiều + 's	These are the children's books.
