Zero Conditional

if + present simple, present simple
(facts, general truths)



First Conditional

if + present simple, will + base verb
(real possibilities)



Second Conditional

if + past simple, would/could + base verb
(imaginary present or future)



Third Conditional

if + past perfect,
would/could/might + have + past participle
(imaginary past)
