

PLURAL NOUNS WORKSHEET ?

RULE 1: Words ending in SS, SH, CH, X, or Z → add -ES

Examples: bus → buses brush → brushes bench → benches box → boxes quiz → quizzes

RULE 2: Words ending in FF, F, or FE → usually add -S

Examples: cliff → cliffs roof → roofs safe → safes giraffe → giraffes

**Some words ending in F/FE are exceptions: knife → knives, leaf → leaves, wolf → wolves.*
