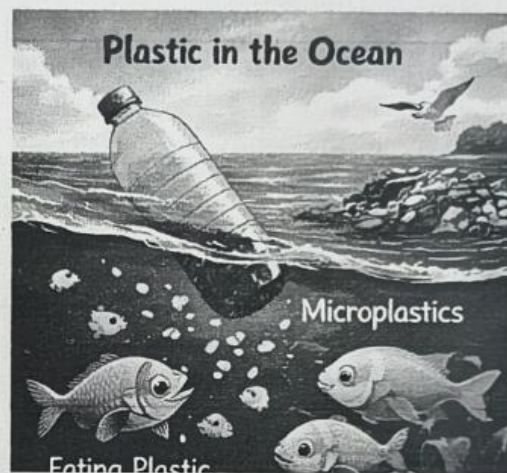
Read the text carefully. Look for words are in bold (dark letters) because these words are answer to your questions.
