A. THEORY

I. GRAMMAR: NON-DEFINING RELATIVE CLAUSES (Mệnh đề quan hệ không xác định)

Mệnh đề quan hệ không xác định (Non-defining Relative clauses) là một mệnh đề phụ đứng sau danh từ, được sử dụng để bổ sung thông tin phụ cho danh từ đã được xác định rõ ràng. Khi bỏ mệnh đề này đi, mệnh đề chính vẫn đủ nghĩa và người đọc vẫn hiểu rõ đối tượng đang được nói đến là ai/cái gì.

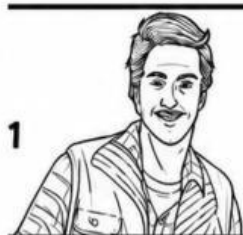
