PAST SIMPLE

We use **Past Simple** to talk about actions that happened **in the past**.

AFFIRMATIVE (+)

I / you / he / she / it + V₂ (past)
We / they + V₂ (past)

I **visited** my grandma yesterday.
They **played** football last Saturday.

NEGATIVE (-)

I / you / he / she / it + did not (didn't) + V₁
We / they + did not (didn't) + V₁

She **didn't watch** TV yesterday.
We **didn't go** to school last Monday.

QUESTIONS (?)

Did + I / you / he / she / it / we / they + V₁ (base)?

Did you **see** a movie yesterday?

Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.
