Grammar 1: Gerunds (-ing)

Gerunds are verbs that end in **-ing** and they act like nouns in a sentence.

Gerund as Subject

Painting is my favorite hobby.

Gerund as Object

He enjoys **watching** TV.

Smoking is not good for health.

My sister enjoys **knitting**.



Grammar 2: Could

Could has different meanings.

Like **can**, it can mean possibility or ability.

- I **could** paint a picture of the school.
- When I was kid, I **could** run fast.
